WHEREAS, the City of Long Branch has the need to contract with appraisal firms to provide real estate appraisal services and potential expert witness testimony in various court actions for the contract year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, and has determined that it is in the City's best interest to establish a pre-approved pool of qualified appraisal firms from which to award contracts; and

WHEREAS, the City, through a Fair and Open Process, advertised on its website the solicitation for receipt of qualifications from appraisal firms for said services, publicly opened and read on June 30, 2008 (Fair and Open #016-08), and the following firms submitted a qualifications:

- Gagliano Appraisal, LLC**, Shrewsbury, NJ
- McGuire Associates, LLC**, Jersey City, NJ
- Integra Realty Resources**, Toms River, NJ
- ARD Appraisal Company**, Clark, NJ

WHEREAS, the qualification submissions were reviewed by the Mayor and Business Administrator, and it was determined that Gagliano Appraisal, McGuire Associates and Integra Realty Resources have adequate experience, staffing, and resources to be considered for appraisal assignments that the City may require during the coming contract year, and further the Mayor and Administrator have recommended that these three firms be included in the 2009-2010 Appraisal Services Pool and awarded open-ended contracts; and

WHEREAS, all contractors awarded professional services contracts are required to comply with City Ordinance #18-05, and by execution of the contract documents and Political Contribution Affidavit, each firm acknowledges that it complies with the Ordinance and has not made any political contributions that would bar it from being awarded a contract with the City of Long Branch; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Local Public Contracts Law, the City may authorize open-ended contracts to these firms, with the provision of certification of funds provided by issuance of a Purchase Order prior to any work being assigned or performed, and based upon availability of adequate funds.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN AMOUNTS TO VARIOUS QUALIFIED PRIVATE COMMUNITIES FOR SNOW REMOVAL COSTS INCURRED DURING THE WINTER SEASON OF 2008-2009 AND STREET LIGHTING COSTS INCURRED DURING THE YEAR 2009

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Condominium Services Act, also known as the "Kelly Act", N.J.S.A. 40:67-23.2, et. seq., municipalities are required to provide certain services to qualified private communities a reimbursement payment therefore; and

WHEREAS, the services to be provided (or reimbursed) include the removal of snow and ice from the roads and streets within the qualified private communities, as well as the payment of costs associated with the provision of lighting along the roads and streets within the qualified private communities, to the extent of payment for the electricity required but no including the installation or maintenance of lamps, standard, wiring or other equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City has calculated the amounts that are required to be paid, as a reimbursement, to the various qualified private communities within the City for snow removal costs incurred during the winter season of 2008-2009, and for street lighting costs during the year 2009; and

WHEREAS, the amounts to be reimbursed are specified in more detail on the attached Schedule A; and

WHEREAS, the total amount to be reimbursed for snow removal costs incurred during the winter season of 2008-2009 is \$2,099.89; and

WHEREAS, the total amount to be reimbursed for street lighting costs incurred during the year 2009 is \$8,779.68; and

WHEREAS, the grand total reimbursement amount for the above years, which includes both the snow removal and street lighting costs referenced above, equates to \$10,879.57; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Branch wishes to authorize payment of the above reimbursement amounts to the various qualified private communities, which shall be paid in full satisfaction of the City's obligations under the Kelly Act for snow removal costs for the winter season of 2008-2009, and for street lighting costs for the year 2009; and

WHEREAS, the specific amounts to be reimbursed to each of the qualified private communities for the years in question are shown in more detail on Schedule A.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Long Branch as follows:

1 - That the City hereby authorizes a refund in the total amount of \$2,099.89 to the various qualified private communities listed on the attached Schedule A., in the specific amounts referenced on the said schedule, pursuant to the Kelly act, for snow removal costs for the winter season of 2008-2009.

2 - That the City hereby authorizes a refund in the total amount of \$8,779.68 to the various qualified private communities listed on the attached Schedule A., in the specific amounts referenced on the said schedule, pursuant to the Kelly act, for street lighting costs for the year 2009.

3 - That the refunds authorizing herein shall be forwarded to the official "Association" addresses that are on file with the City of Long Branch for each of the qualified private communities referenced on the attached schedule. If there is no official "Association" address on file with the City, or if there is any problem associated with locating the proper payee or proper address for any specific refund authorized herein, then the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to retain the refund amount for the benefit of the qualified private community until such time as an investigation has been made and distribution has been authorized by the City Attorney's Office.

4 - That the aforesaid reimbursement payments are being made in full satisfaction of the City's obligations under the Kelly Act for snow removal costs for the winter season of 2008-2009 and for street lighting costs for the year 2009.

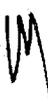

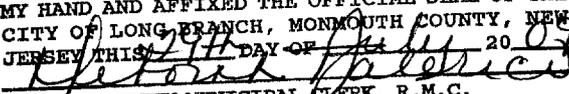
