RESOLUTION - CHILDHOOD CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, 36 children in the United States will be diagnosed with cancer each day and at an average age of six-years old; and

WHEREAS, one out of five children diagnosed with cancer will not survive the disease; and

WHEREAS, the types of cancers that affect children are most often very different from those that affect adults; and

WHEREAS, childhood cancer spares no socioeconomic, ethnic, racial, or geographic class; and

WHEREAS, pediatric cancer is the leading cause of death by disease in the US children 15 years of age; and

WHEREAS, the causes of most pediatric cancers are largely unknown and not strongly linked to lifestyle, unlike adult cancers; and

WHEREAS, two-thirds of childhood cancer patients will develop long-lasting chronic conditions resulting from treatment; and

WHEREAS, the childhood cancer rates have been rising for the past few decades, and approximately 11, 630 children in the US under the age of 15 will be diagnosed with cancer in 2013; and

WHEREAS, cancer kills more kids than AIDS, asthma, cystic fibrosis, diabetes and muscular dystrophy combined; and

WHEREAS, in the last 25 years, only 2 drugs have been specifically developed for children's cancer; and

WHEREAS, less than 5% of the federal government's total funding for cancer research is dedicated to childhood cancers, and only about 3% of funds raised for the National Cancer Institute go directly to pediatric cancer research; and

WHEREAS, the funding for pediatric cancer research has gone down steadily since 2003; and

WHEREAS, despite the facts, childhood cancer research is vastly and consistently underfunded; and

WHEREAS, despite major advances in treatment, it is still critically important to conduct research and increase awareness regarding pediatric cancer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor along with the City Council of the City of Long Branch hereby proclaims September 2013 as "Childhood Cancer Awareness Month" in the City of Long Branch in order to help raise awareness of pediatric cancer and its victims.

Sairs Avenue Phase II is a North-South two lane minor urban arterial road within the City of Long Branch. It provides access to the commercial district on Brighton Avenue and provides access to Monmouth Medical Center. Additionally, it provides summer resort and New Jersey Transit access to the nearby train station.

The roadway primarily serves city residents and the local commercial district. Sairs Avenue connects two major collector roadways within the City, Bath Avenue, and Brighton Avenue as shown on the attached location map. In addition to large volume of local traffic, Sairs Avenue serves the multi family zoning district which, requires the safe and efficient roadway that the proposed improvements will provide. The sidewalks are heavily used by the children and families for walking to the medical, NJ Transit and commercial services within the area. Sairs Avenue also serves as a collector road used to travel to commercial districts located both North and South of the roadway, Monmouth Medical Center, seasonal summer resort access and a NJ Transit train station. In recent years, there is a significant increase in summer resort traffic, which has also contributes to the deterioration of the roadway surface.

The road has areas of moderate to severe pavement deterioration, including widespread surface distress cracks and sunken pavement. 



Scope of Work

Troutmans Creek Drainage System Phase II is an existing piped creek located in the central part of the City of Long Branch. The system services the surrounding residential and commercial areas and directs stormwater runoff to the Shrewsbury River and eventually to the Atlantic Ocean.

The system was severely impacted from the Hurricane Irene storm in 2011 and Super Storm Sandy in 2012. Extensive erosion damage created blockages within the system which have caused local flooding in intersections along the piped creek as well as basement and building flooding of nearby structures. The City utilized it's own funding and had 10 days of cleaning and televising done by an independent contractor. This evaluation provided needed information to identify areas that require attention. Utilizing NJDOT funding the most critical crossing is under repair. Cleaning of the piping system revealed other areas of concern which pose a safety hazard for local residents and motorist.

The City is proposing to continue the repair of the piping system downstream from Sairs Avenue along Matilda Terrace and Cottage Place. This work will provide a safe transfer of stormwater from the roadway to the piped stormwater system. In addition to stormwater improvements the City will repair the curb, sidewalks and roadway as required. These improvements will satisfy NJDOT design standards.

For this project, as with all projects constructed within the City, all work will be coordinated with utility companies to insure that utility restoration and relocation will be implemented to commencement of construction. The City, under ordinance 297-49.1, will implement a five year moratorium on any utility work to protect the roadway surface from unnecessary openings.




